Five additional Abellio ScotRail fleets to offer high-quality Icomera Wi-Fi

These fleets join the existing C170 fleet of 55 trains already served by the mobile Internet pioneers, bringing Icomera's ScotRail Wi-Fi service to 184 trains in total – more than half of Abellio ScotRail's current fleet. Customers travelling around Strathclyde, in particular, will benefit from this rollout.

Later this year, Icomera will integrate their onboard solution with ScotRail's backhaul station Wi-Fi for the transfer of onboard CCTV data.
